The Red Cross is partnering with Pitney Bowes this holiday season for the Holiday Mail for Heroes campaign. For the second year in a row, we're collecting holiday cards to distribute to American service members, veterans and their families in the United States and around the world. Our goal is to collect and distribute one million holiday cards to spread holiday cheer and facilitate thanks to these brave individuals and families."

We know how talented our customers are, and we know that you can make some awesome cards! You can make a special one for the troops, or simply make an extra card when you are making your family cards..... We even have some materials at the store that you can sit & make a card to send - bring your family in to make a card too!

Please bring your card in to the store between now & December 1; we will display them for inspiration, and then we will send them to the Red Cross on December 6.

Here are some guidelines from the Red Cross:

- Please sign all cards.
- Please send cards as opposed to long letters.
- Please do not include email or home addresses on the cards.
- Please do not include inserts of any kind, including photos.
- Please do not use loose glitter.
- All cards received may be used in program publicity efforts, including appearing in broadcast, print or online mediums.

Let's create lots of cards from the Tri-City area of Michigan, and show our support for the troops!

Also, please remember, we are still collecting Cell Phones for Soldiers...

"Cell Phones for Soldiers hopes to turn old cell phones into more than 12 million minutes of prepaid calling cards for U.S. troops stationed overseas in 2008. To do so, they expect to collect 50,000 cell phones each month through a network of more than 3,000 collection sites across the country. The phones are sent to ReCellular, which pays Cell Phones for Soldiers for each donated phone – enough to provide an hour of talk time to soldiers abroad. Americans will replace an estimated 130 million cell phones this year, “with the majority of phones either discarded or stuffed in a drawer. Most people don’t realize that the small sacrifice of donating their unwanted phones can have a tremendous benefit for a worthy cause like Cell Phones for Soldiers.” www.cellphonesforsoldiers.com
